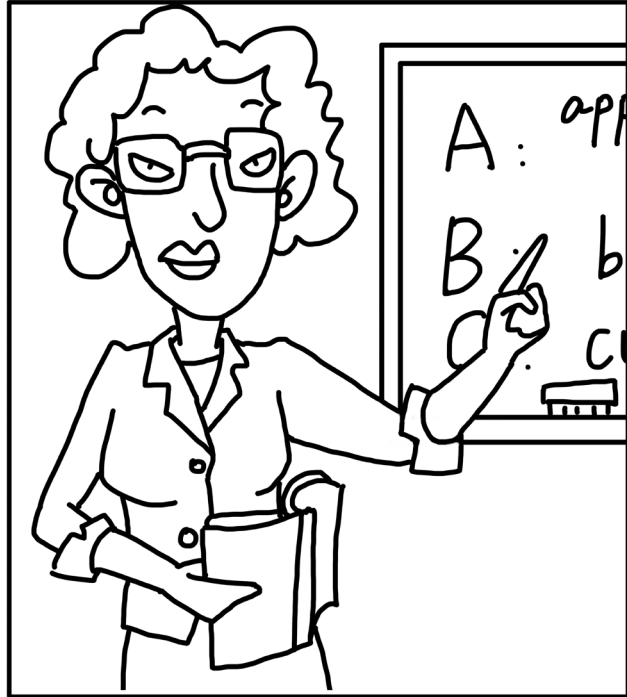
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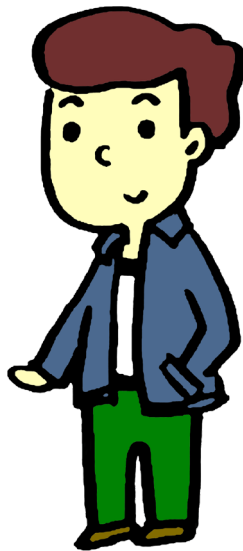
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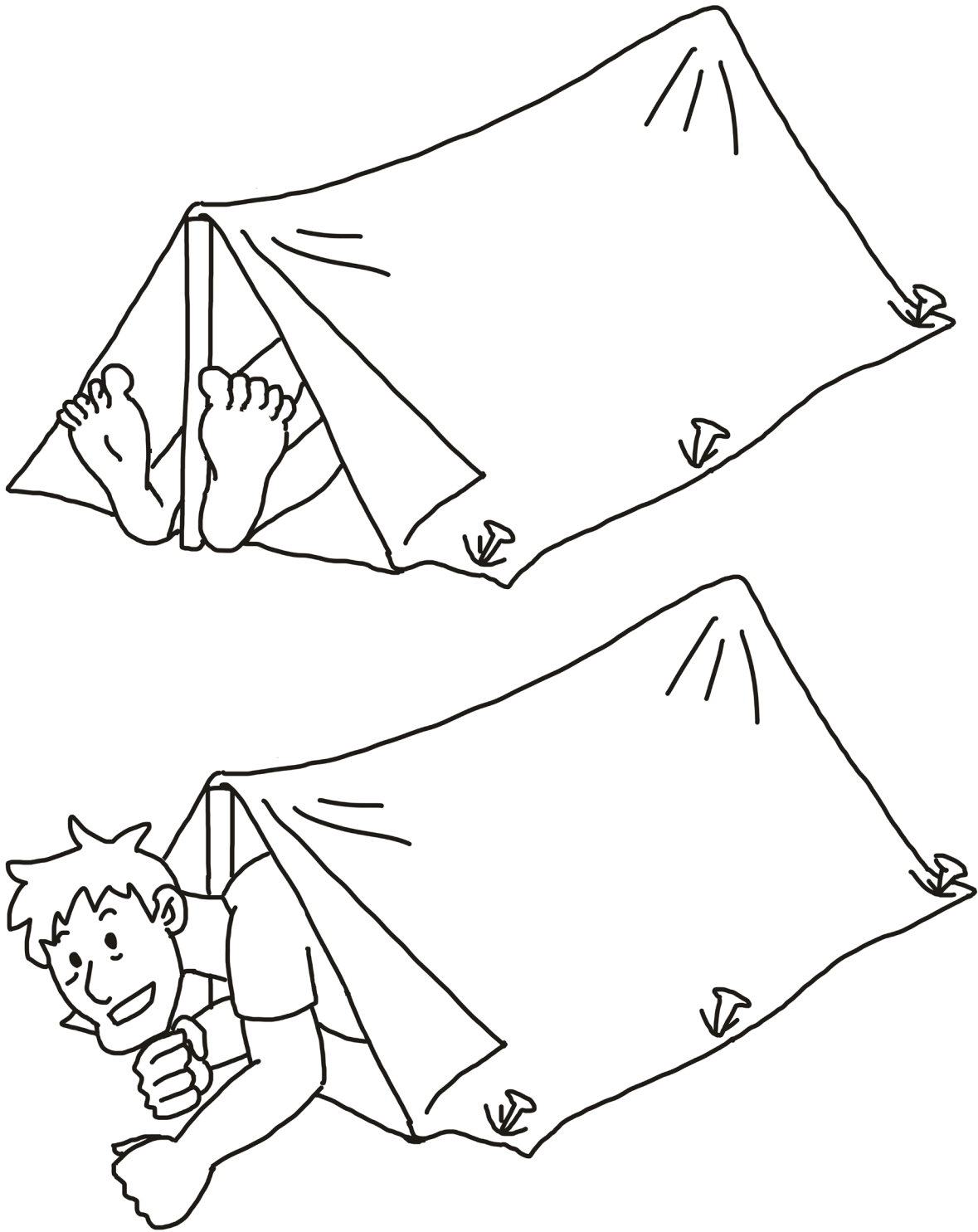
**Teacher:** Teach the children about jobs and places in the community. Invite them to color the picture.

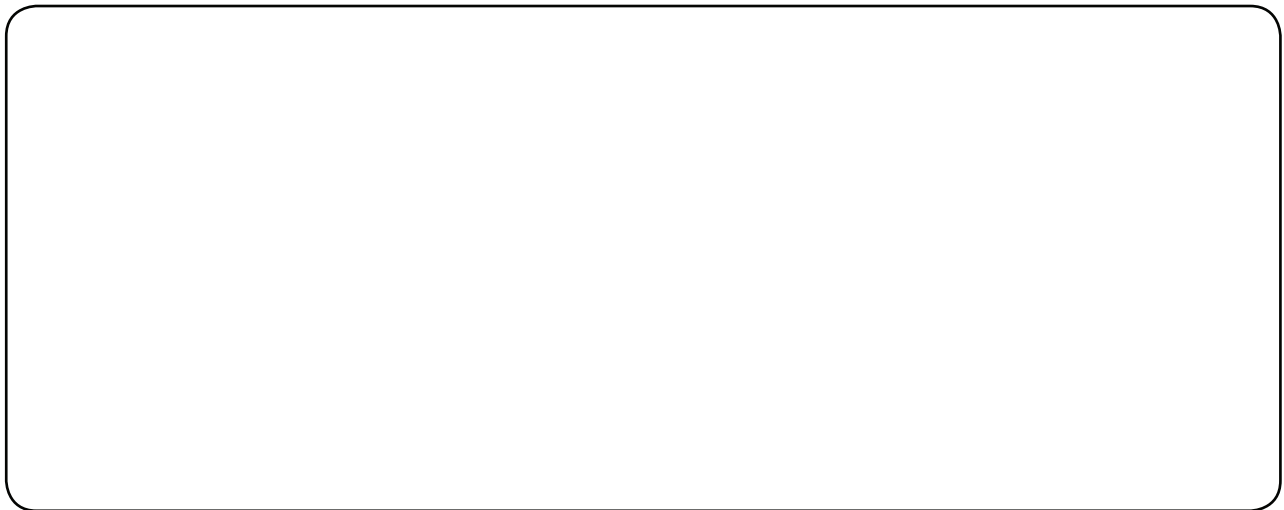
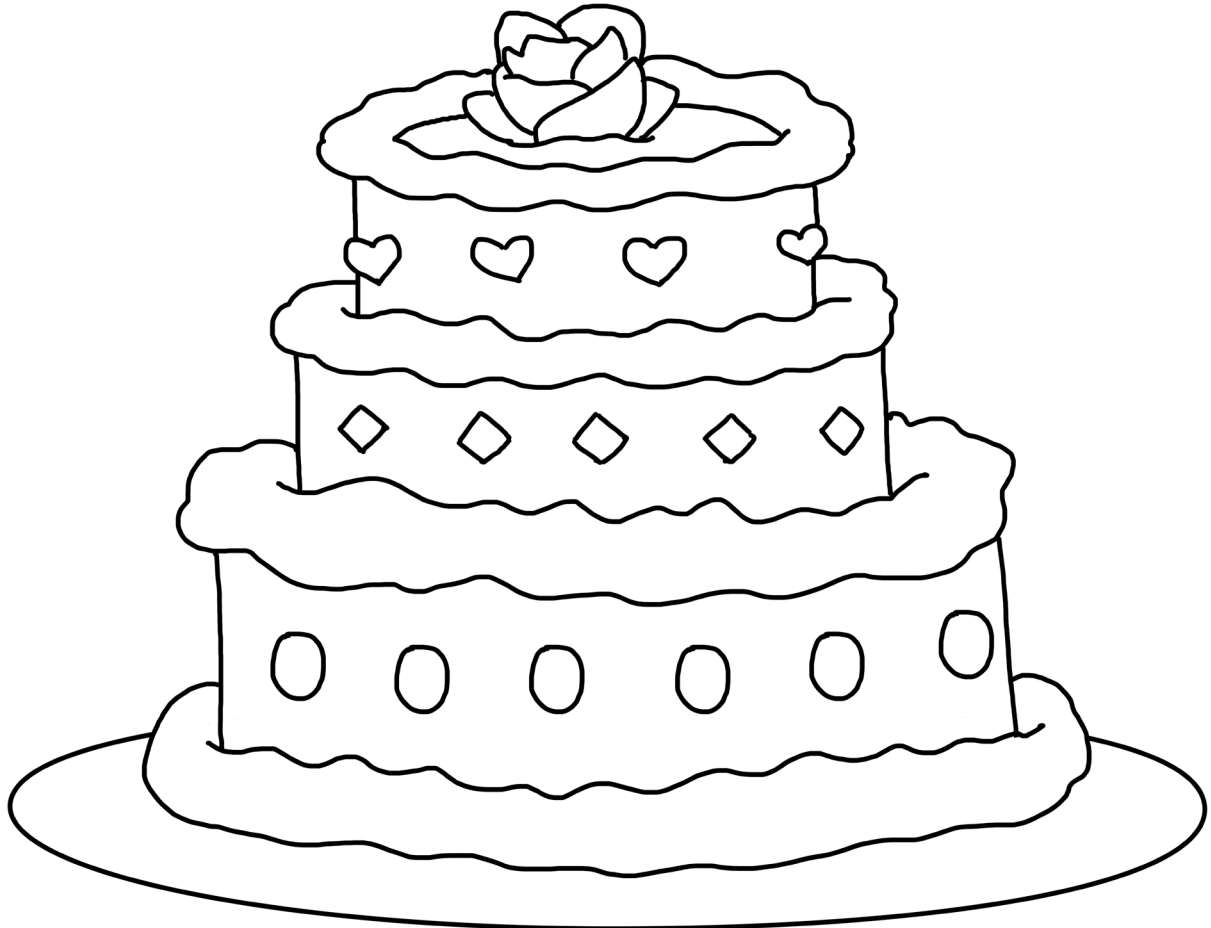

# Inside and Outside



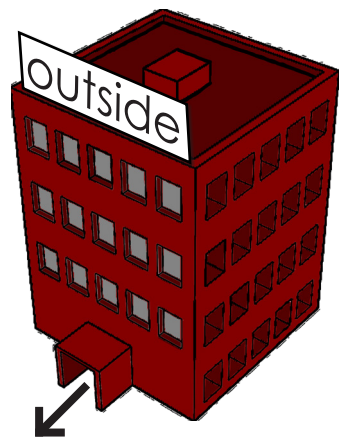
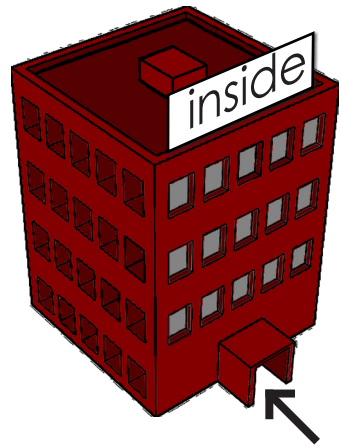

## Cake Colors



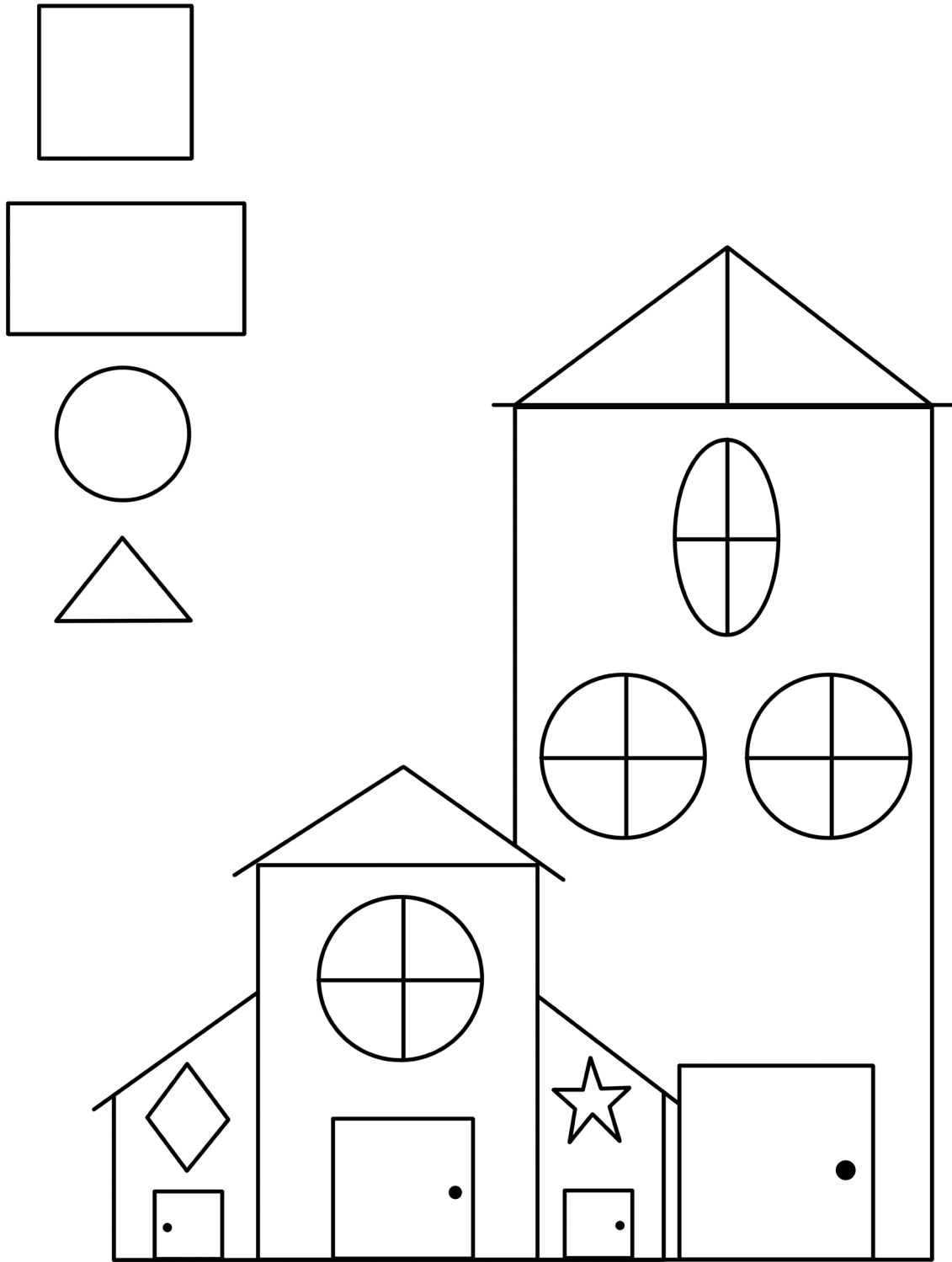

# Inside Jobs and Outside Jobs



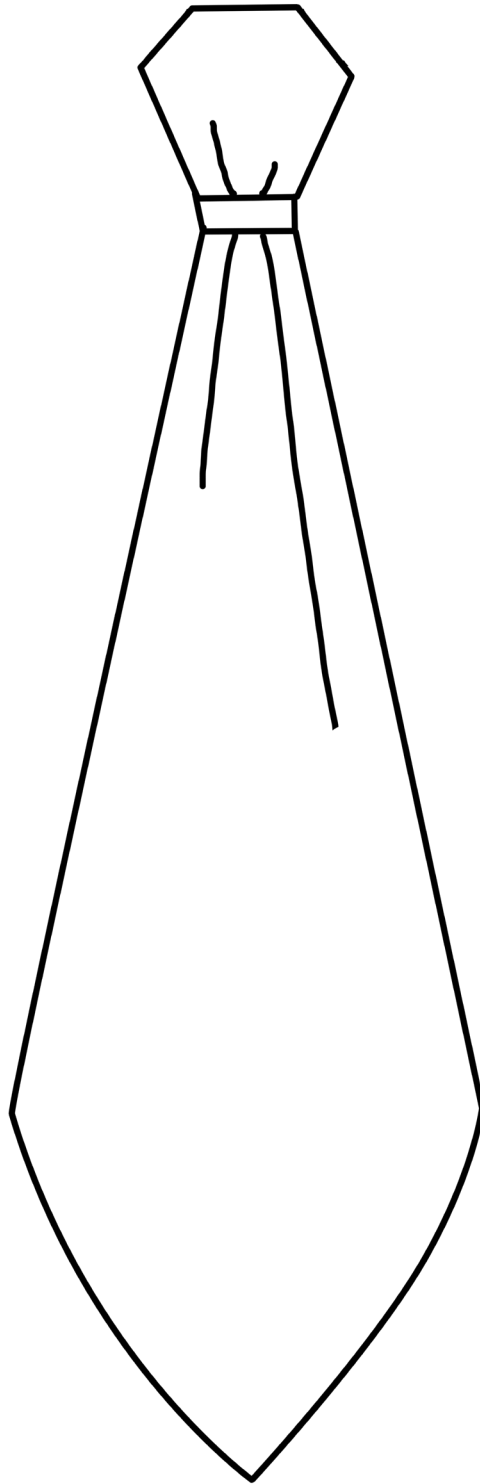
**Teacher:** Review inside and outside with the children. Have the children classify which jobs are inside and outside by connecting the job picture with the building representing inside or outside.

# Find the Shapes



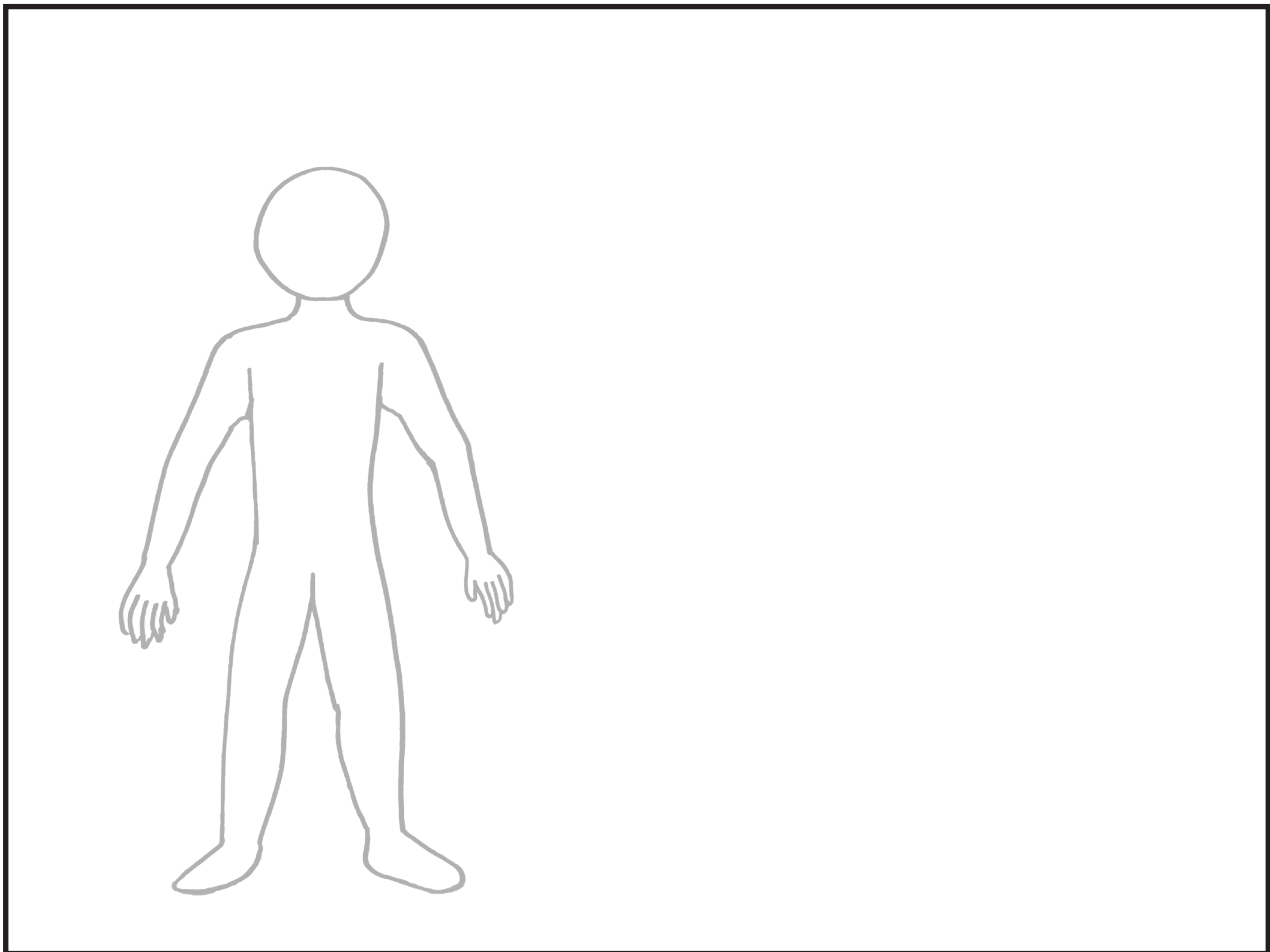
**Teacher:** Review what a building is and who makes a building (a builder). Review the shapes. Instruct the children to find and color the shapes in the picture.

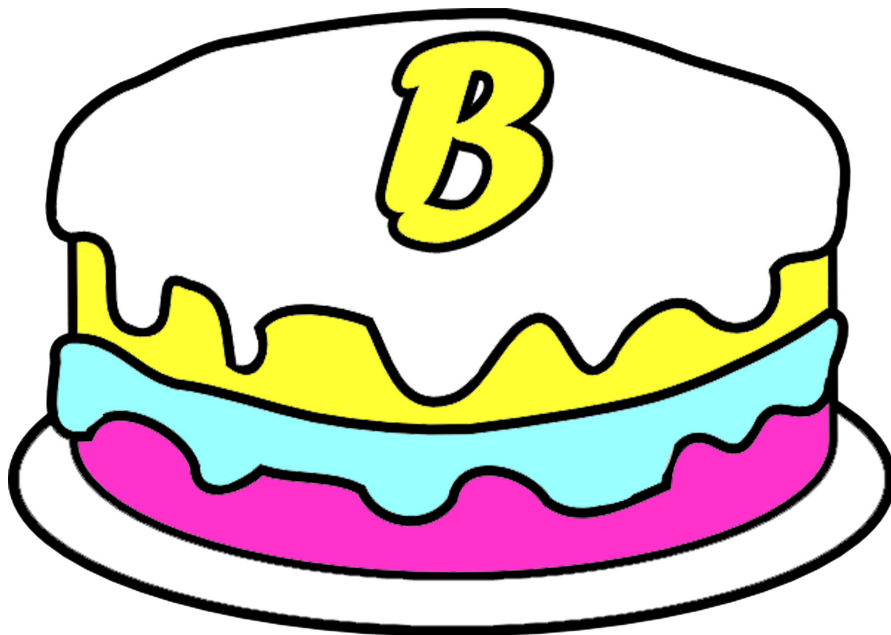

**Teacher:** Teach this nursery rhyme. Review the letter b, baker, and baby. Instruct the children to practice at home.

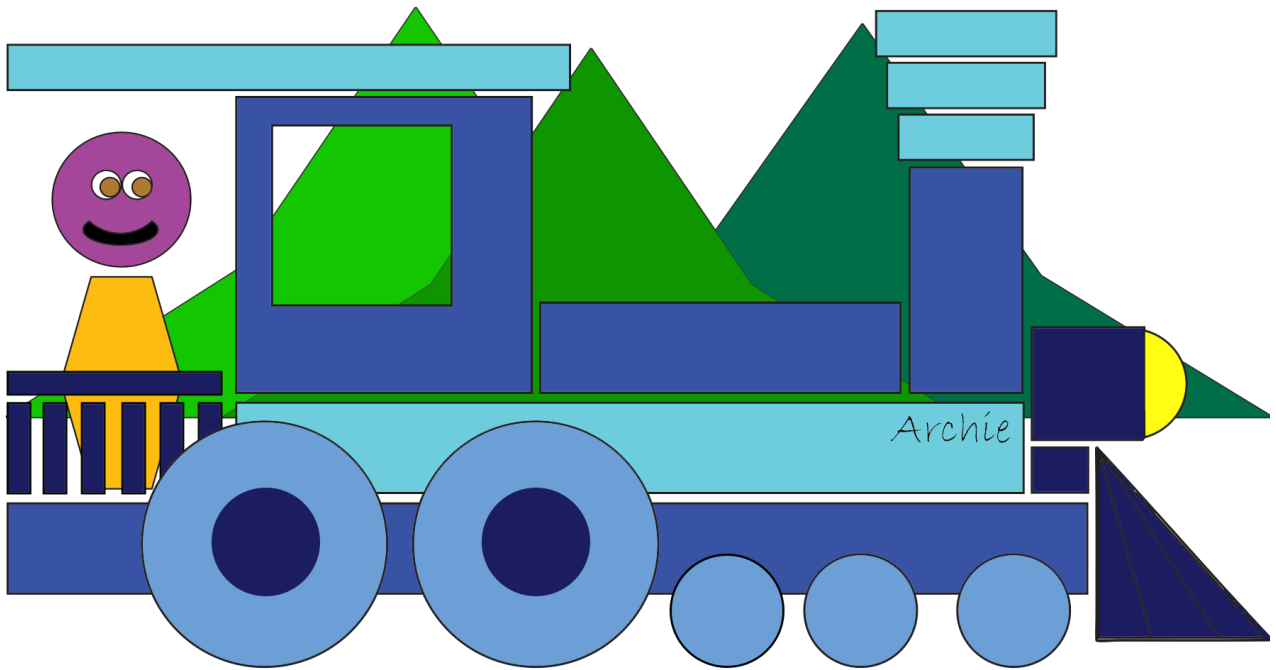
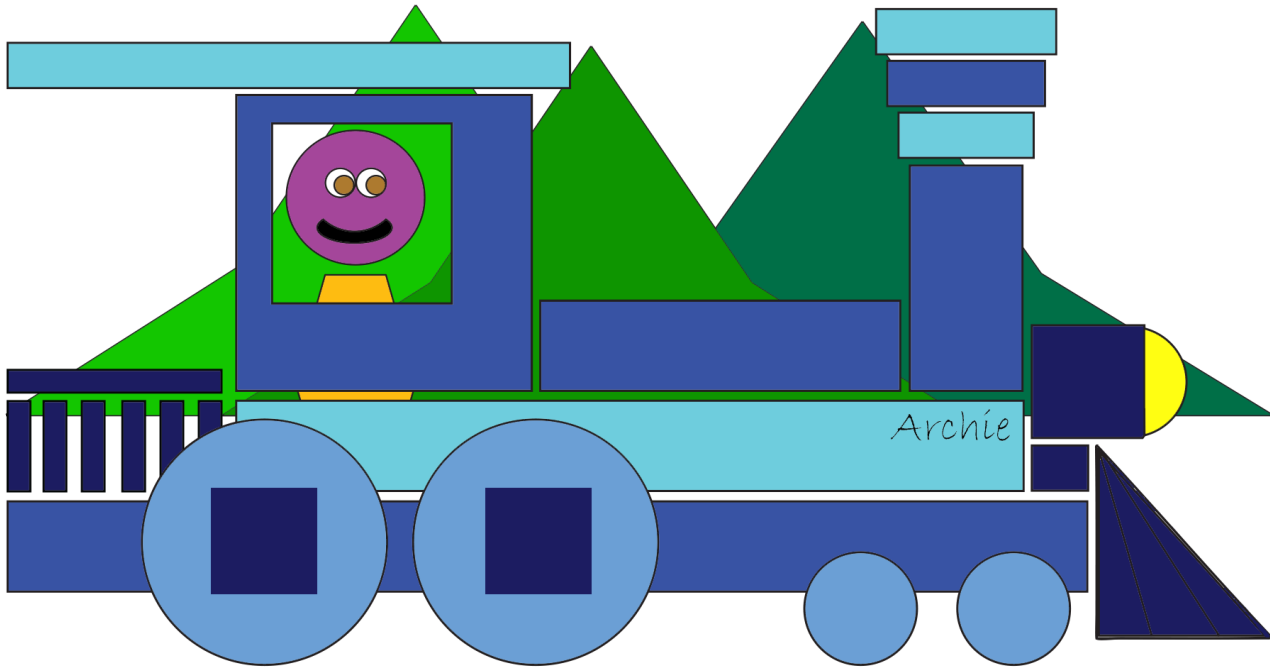
